Since 1986, Leadership Coffeyville has been training community leaders to do good work. Leadership Coffeyville is a non-profit organization that focuses on developing leaders to meet the evolving challenges facing our community today. The class has two major components, Leadership skills training and an overall snapshot of the Coffeyville community. In Leadership training, students learn about Leadership Styles, Consensus Building, Active Listening, Team Building, Appreciative Inquiry and many more. "The class will meet with several community leaders in areas such as city government, health care, education and industry. These meetings will be an opportunity to ask questions and learn more about what makes our community thrive.

Class sizes are typically limited to less than 20 people. Tuition is \$350 per student and often is sponsored by the employer. Scholarships may be available for those who qualify and need financial assistance to participate.
